1. Opening Prayer at 7:03pm—Fr. Wand
2. Brief Check-In by Vestry Members
3. Minutes from Previous sessions-Phyllis made the motion to accept the minutes as written, Jim 2nd. All were in favor.
4. Fall Pledge Campaign results to date, actions to be taken - Joe Bardroff will join us
 - a. 36 Pledges for around \$88,000.
 - b. Letter to go out to all those who have not returned pledge cards. Wait a week then will get a list to the vestry to make calls to those who have not returned their pledges
5. Financial Report (see attached doc)
 - a. Pledge income consistent with 2019; contributions not so much
 - b. Other comments by beloved Treasurer
 - c. Next Vestry meeting we will discuss 2021 Budget which will be adopted December 14
6. Outreach continuation:
 - a. Collection—Donations: Updated figures for food pantry \$8040, amount disbursed \$8000
 - b. Fair Acres “tree hangers” collection moving forward. There are 30 resident cards to disperse.
7. Property Committee Report—Phyllis Russell, Janet Russello
 - a. Jim Geiger: Big Thank you to Jim for always being there when needed.
 - b. Anti-viral fogger/sprayer: Janet made the motion to approve the purchase of the smaller sprayer and liquid subject to the approval of the executive committee and Barbara 2nd. Rosemary will do some additional research and will notify the executive committee with results and purchase once product is vetted.
 - i. smaller sprayer would cost \$699.99
 - ii. Solution is \$117 per 4 gallons.
 - c. Christmas Worship Schedule: poll the congregation during calls to see who would attend and at what times would work. Proposing 3pm and 6pm on Christmas Eve and 9am on Christmas day.
 - d. Progress report: Audio/visual Equipment
 - i. Internet is Done
 - ii. Wednesday is the installation of camera/mikes/audio. May need to complete Thurs.

- e. Bill Diamond completed the work on the lights on the Altar
 - f. Boiler-\$1500 estimated cost to repair.
 - g. There is one radiator in the church with a crack. This has been shut off. Will see if the church is warm enough without the radiator. Will not be repairing during winter.
 - h. Lock put on the door to the vesting sacristy. \$370. One Key for all locks.
 - i. Insurance Coverage for steeple repair will not to be covered. The drains were likely the reason for the flooding. We will probably need to hire roofer and contractor to do some of the work. Sean McCully is working with us.
 - j. Sexton's house repairs. Work in progress. Hole in the ceiling, vanity in bathroom,...ect.
 - k. Rectory dishwasher needs repair. \$250 to repair.
 - l. Locks on the shed have been changed. Pictures of all the equipment so we have an inventory.
 - m. Need a field day to clear the leaves
 - n. Calls out to a few landscaping companies to get quotes for next years mowing.
8. As of November 16th, we will be an Amazon Smile charity group. Our church will receive a percentage of sales.
 9. Priest-in-charge Report: wants some help with worship. Will start having readers. 11/15-Rosemary, 11/22-Marsha, 11/29-Jude.
 10. Message to parish including Constant Contact message: food Pantry, Leaf Blowing, purchasing a mister to disinfect the church. Will start to use Readers. Did you get your pledge cards? What times for Christmas services?
